


Important Notice of Evacuation Areas in Case of Disaster

Due to the fire at the Tachikawa Dainana Junior High School gymnasium on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, gymnasium is unavailable. When using Dainana Junior High School as primary evacuation center, classroom building will be opened. Depending on the condition of the evacuees, moving to the secondary evacuation center (Nishisuna Study House, Nishisuna Hall, Ichiban Welfare Hall) Might be necessary.

## How to Evacuate at Home • • •

Home evacuation is a way to evacuate at home when there is no risk of collapse or burnout in time of a earthquake.

You can receive supplies at the evacuation center, while staying at home. It is important for each household to prepare for an earthquake on a daily basis, such as stockpiling water, food, and daily necessities.



## Consider the Placement Space for Furniture

Arrange furniture layouts to avoid blocking the doors and evacuation routes. Do not put things around doorway or hallway of the room, considering the direction of placement, paying attention to the protruding drawers.
