Contact the Waste Management Division for details.



Please ensure your waste is put out by 8:00 a.m. Waste placed after this time may not be collected.

Waste collection starts at 8:00 a.m. Depending on road construction or the volume of waste, collection may continue into the afternoon. Waste put out after collection has been completed will not be picked up.

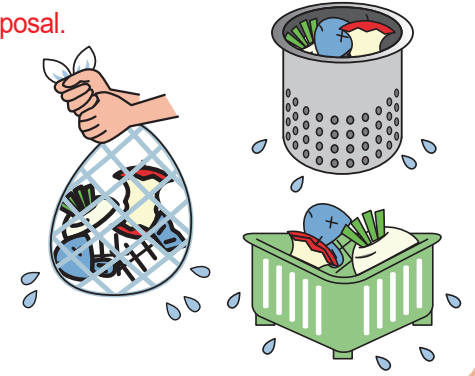


Precautions when disposing of waste

Please drain liquids from food waste before disposal.

Food waste contains about 80% water. Draining it helps reduce the bag's weight and makes it more hygienic.

※ About 30% of the combustible waste from homes is kitchen trash.



Free waste collection services

Use transparent or semi-transparent bags up to 45 liters for disposal.

Paper diapers



Write "Omutsu" on the bag. Please flush any human waste down in the toilet before disposal.

※ Please dispose of pet diapers, sanitary products, incontinence pads, and similar items in combustible waste bags.

Fallen leaves and weeds



- Dispose of up to 5 bags at a time. Do not put soil in the bags (the city cannot handle it).
- Please place cultivated flowers and fruits in designated combustible waste bags.

If mercury-containing products (such as fluorescent lamps, mercury thermometers, mercury air thermometers, blood pressure monitors (non-electric type), dry cell batteries, and button cells) are mixed into household combustible waste, they can significantly impact waste disposal. Please dispose of mercury-containing products as hazardous waste.

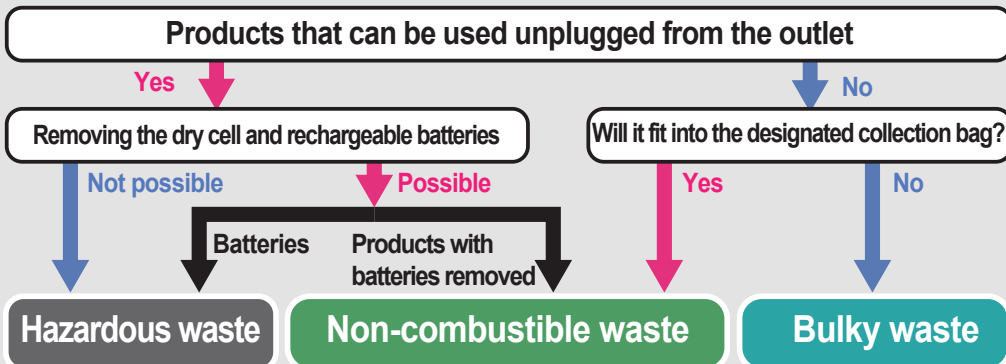

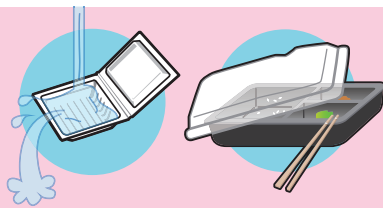

Points to note when putting out Waste

- Be sure to wipe off dirt and lightly rinse items with water before disposal.
- Do not dispose of leftover lunch boxes, disposable chopsticks, or similar items in waste bags.
- Items that are dirty or contain foreign materials cannot be recycled.
- Items containing other materials, such as metal or rubber, should be disposed of as "non-combustible waste."
- Items that do not fit into a 45-liter bag should be disposed of as "bulky waste."
- Please cooperate by returning items to in-store collection points at the place of purchase.

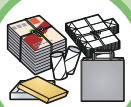


Common mistakes (wrong waste category)

- Soiled containers (e.g., ice cream cups, instant noodle cups, yogurt containers), items with water-repellent coatings
➔ Combustible waste

Never put the following items in a waste bag.

- Hypodermic needles and syringes ➔ Not accepted by the city
- Scissors and razors ➔ Non-combustible waste
- Lighters and mobile batteries ➔ Hazardous waste



Magazines, Books, Misc. papers (Recyclables)

Every two weeks

Put magazines and books in paper bags or tie them crosswise with string.



Put shredded paper in a transparent or semi-transparent bag (up to 45 liters), squeeze out the air, tie the opening, and put it out for collection.

Acceptable waste

Magazines, books, sticky notes, memo paper, flyers, pamphlets, documents, canned beer paper packaging boxes, tissue boxes, paper packages, aluminum-coated paper cartons

Precautions when putting out waste

- Remove the plastic opening from the tissue box and dispose of it on the "Plastics" collection day.
- Cut off the transparent film from window envelopes and dispose of it on "Combustible waste" collection day.



Let's recycle scrap paper!

Small pieces of paper that are often disposed of as combustible waste, such as memo paper, can also be recycled in the same way as magazines and books. Since miscellaneous paper comes in various sizes, placing it in a paper bag may be more convenient than tying it with string. If a paper bag is not available, sandwich the paper between magazines or similar items and tie it up in the same manner as magazines and books.



Common mistakes (wrong waste category)

Even if a recycling mark (紙) is printed, it cannot be recycled.

Paper with odors (such as laundry detergent boxes), soiled paper (such as used tissues), waterproof or coated paper (such as paper cups and yogurt containers), photographs, receipts, iron-on transfer paper (such as stuffing found in bags or shoes), carbon-backed paper (such as receipts), vinyl-coated paper, instant noodle cup lids, padded envelopes, and pressure-sealed postcards.

Dispose of all of these items as combustible waste.



Paper cartons (milk cartons, etc.) (Recyclables)

Every two weeks

Rinse inside carton, unfold and flatten. Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



- Remove the plastic spout from paper cardboard cartons and dispose of it as "Plastics." (See p. 17.)

※ Paper cartons with an aluminum coating on the inside should be disposed of as miscellaneous paper.



Newspapers / Flyers (Recyclables)

Every two weeks

Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



If you request disposal through a retailer, please attach the label provided by the retailer.

Items with this label attached will not be collected by the city.

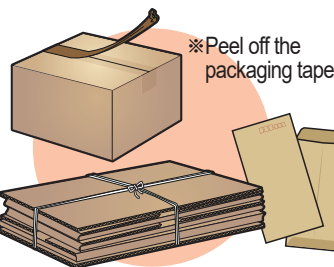
※ Advertising paper and flyers, except for newspaper inserts, should be disposed of as miscellaneous paper.



Cardboard / Brown papers (Recyclables)

Every two weeks

Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



※ Peel off the packaging tape.

- Dispose of dirty items, such as pizza boxes, as combustible waste.
- Brown paper may also be disposed of by placing it in a brown paper envelope.

※ Brown paper has a brown-colored torn cross-section.

[Paper recyclables cannot be recycled if they get wet from rain.]

Collection will still be carried out on rainy days, but if possible, please wait and put out your waste on the next collection day.

If you do put out waste on a rainy day, please place it in the usual location.

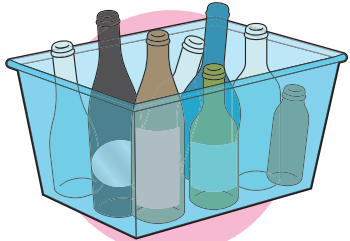

(Bottles for beverages, food, cosmetics, etc.)

Once a week

Put in a basket or bucket.



- In multi-unit housing, please place glass bottles in the designated containers (e.g., baskets) provided.
- Do not put glass bottles into plastic bags.
- Glass bottles can be disposed of without removing the labels.

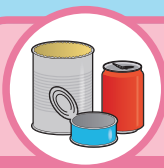

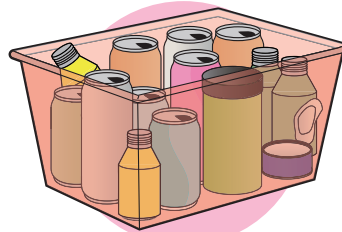

- In multi-unit housing, please place cans in the designated containers (e.g., baskets) provided.
- Do not put can into plastic bags.

Common mistakes (wrong waste category)

Spray cans → Wednesday collection (see p. 20)

18-liter drums → Bulky waste (see pp. 22–23)

Paint cans → If cleaned of remaining paint, use designated non-combustible waste bags.

※ The city does not collect paint cans with remaining paint.



PET bottles (Recyclables)

(PET bottles for drinks, alcohol, and specific seasonings.)

Once a week

Use transparent or translucent waste bags with a capacity of up to 45 liters. ※You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.

Bottles for drinking water, juice, and other beverages or food



PET
This mark serves as a guide



①Remove cap.



②Peel off label.



③Rinse with water.



④Squish sideways.

Please dispose of it in the collection box at the store where you purchased it.

- Rinse lightly with water. Remove the cap and label and dispose of them as plastic. (See p. 17)
- Items other than bottles are not collected; please dispose of them as plastic.

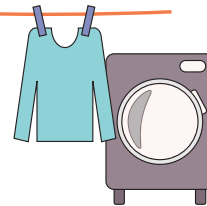

(Clothing, fabrics)

Every two weeks

Use transparent or translucent waste bags with a capacity of up to 45 liters. ※You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.



※Wash and dry used clothing before placing it in a bag.



- Items other than clothing that contain stuffing or padding inside should be disposed of as combustible waste (designated collection bags).

[Recyclable cloth cannot be used as a resource if it gets wet in the rain.]

Collection will still be carried out on rainy days, but if possible, please wait and put your items out on the next collection day.

If you do put items out on a rainy day, please place them in the usual location.

※ Clothing will be reused. Please leave buttons and fasteners attached.

※ Torn clothing can still be disposed of as recyclable cloth.



Pruned branches (Recyclables)

Once a week



- Please cut pruned branches to approximately 50 cm in length (branch diameter up to 15 cm) and tie them with string so they can be held in one hand.
- The weekly disposal limit is up to 5 bundles.

Common mistakes (wrong waste category)

Flowers, processed lumber, bamboo, hemp palm, lacquer, oleander, and gateposts/New Year pine decorations (kadomatsu) should be disposed of as combustible waste (designated collection bags).

NOTE Leaves and weeds should be disposed of as combustible waste. Use transparent or semi-transparent bags. (See p. 15.)

※ **Cassette cylinders and aerosol cans (all cans and bottles containing gas, such as deodorant sprays and hair spray)**

- Be sure to use up the gas.

What should I do if there is still content in the spray bottle?

Use a gas release cap or a similar device to release the remaining gas outdoors in a well-ventilated area, away from open flames, before disposal.

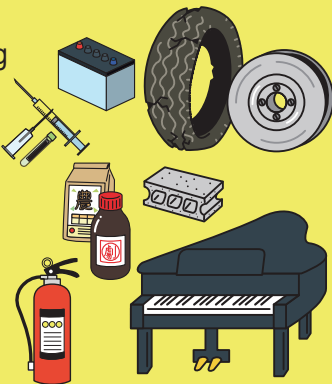

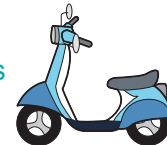
Tires, tire wheels, batteries, vehicle parts, fire extinguishers, large safes, paint, soil/rocks/sand (including fertilizers), pianos, pesticides and other chemicals, gas cylinders (excluding cassette cylinders), toxic chemicals, concrete, bricks, construction debris, oil, medical waste (e.g., syringes), kerosene, automobiles, etc.

Waste generated from indoor renovations or other contractor work cannot be processed by the city. Please ask the contractor to handle disposal, including cleanup.



Two-wheeled vehicles (Motorcycles, Motorized bicycles)

Please first consult the store where you purchased the item. There is also a voluntary initiative by motorcycle manufacturers called the "Motorcycle Recycling System," so please check whether your motorcycle is eligible for collection. (Bicycles and motorcycle parts only are not eligible.)
