There will be three changes from January 2025.

For general household

**Change # 1**

**Collect all plastic items together.**

There will no longer be any distinction between "plastic containers and packaging" and "plastic products"; they will all be collected together as "plastics."



**Change # 2**

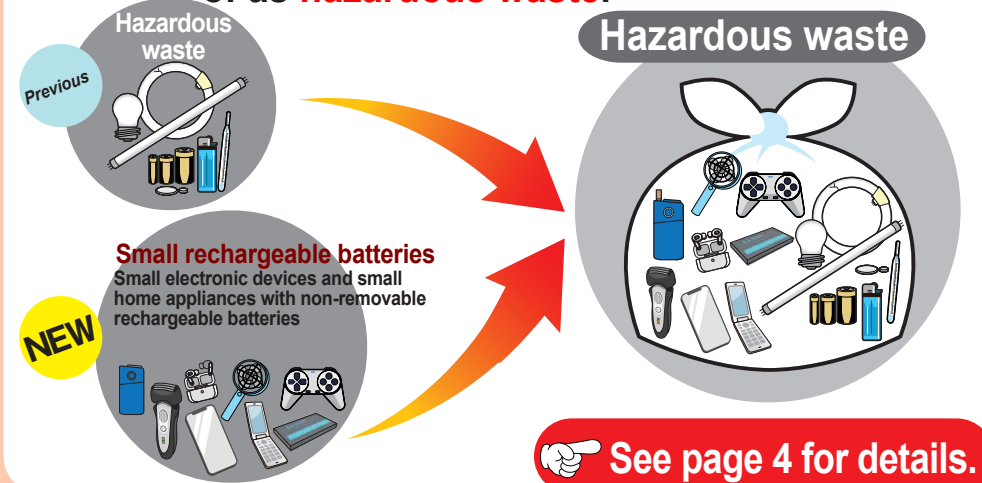
**Collection days for some items have changed.**

**Change # 3**

**Small electronic devices and small home appliances with non-removable rechargeable batteries must be disposed of as hazardous waste.**

## Designated collection bags for household waste

**Pay Service**

Secure by tying the opening of the collection bag when putting out the collection bag.

### Combustible Waste

**Yellow** designated bag



### Non-combustible Waste

**Green** designated bag



You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities. Please dispose of unnecessary collection bags designated by other cities as combustible waste.

You can purchase the city-designated collection bags in units of 10. (We also sell the collection bags as single items and separate sets.)

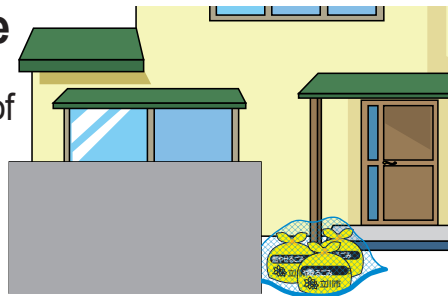

## Waste drop-off location

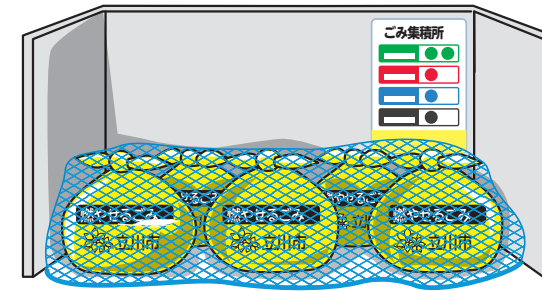
### Single-family house

Put the waste out along your premises by the side of the road.



### Housing complex

Put the waste out to the collection site on your premises.



If you have moved/relocated to Tachikawa City, built a new home, or changed the location of your waste disposal, please contact the Waste Control Division (☎042-531-5517). Please use a net or equivalent so that crows and cats will not tear open garbage bags. We rent bird nets to apartments. Contact the Waste Management Division.



**Be sure to put out waste by 8:00 am. Waste collection is not guaranteed if put out later.**

Our collection work will start at 8:00 am. We try to collect waste at the specified time, but the collection time may change depending on the road conditions.

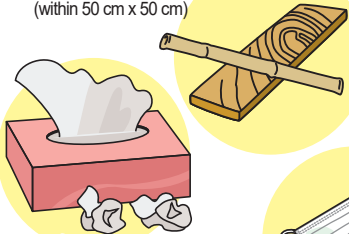

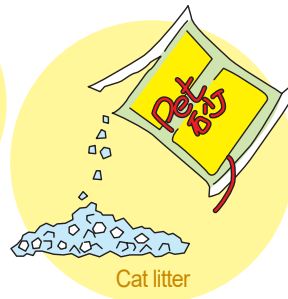

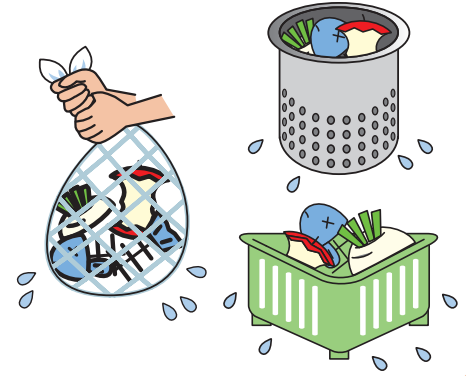

## Precautions when disposing

Please cooperate in draining food waste.

Food waste contains 80% water. Draining helps decrease the bag weight and is more hygienic.

※ About 40% of the combustible waste from homes is kitchen trash.



## Free waste collection services

Use transparent or translucent bags of less than 45 liters for disposal.

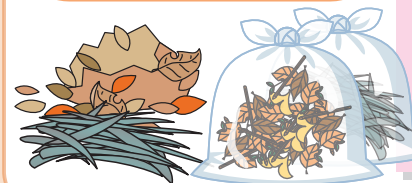
### Paper diapers



Write "Omutsu (Diapers)" on the bag. Drain human waste down the toilet.

※ Please dispose of pet diapers, sanitary products, and incontinence pads in combustible waste bags.

### Fallen leaves and weeds



- Dispose of up to 5 bags at a time. Do not put dirt in the bag. (The city cannot handle it.)
- Please dispose of cultivated flowers and fruits in the designated collection bags for combustible waste.

If mercury-containing products (such as fluorescent lamps, mercury thermometers, mercury air thermometers, blood pressure monitors, dry cell batteries, button cells, and small rechargeable batteries) are mixed into household combustible waste, they can significantly impact waste disposal. Please dispose of mercury-containing products as hazardous waste.

**Knives**  
※ Dull blade part using a rock, or wrap in durable paper. Place write Hamono (Knives 刃物) on it.

**Small household appliances (dryers, irons, etc.)**

※ Put more than half of the umbrella in a bag and tie it up. (Any item that protrudes from the bag, except for an umbrella, is considered bulky waste.)

**Pots, frying pans, other metal products**

## Common mistakes (non-acceptable waste)

Please dispose of them according to the waste classification in parentheses.

- Mobile batteries (Hazardous waste)
- Fluorescent lights, light bulbs (Hazardous waste)
- Spray cans (Spray cans)
- Vacuum cleaner, electric fan (Bulk waste)

※ You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.



# Hazardous waste (Includes small home appliances and small electronic devices with built-in small rechargeable batteries)

Once a week

Please put the waste in a transparent or semi-transparent bag of up to 45 liters and write "hazardous waste 有害ごみ" clearly on the bag before disposing of it.

## Points to note when taking out waste

- Be sure to wipe off dirt and rinse lightly with water before disposal.
- Do not mix in leftover lunch boxes, disposable chopsticks, and similar items.
- If an item is dirty or contains foreign matters, it cannot be recycled. Please cooperate with recycling.
- Items containing other materials, such as metal or rubber, should be disposed of as "non-combustible waste."
- Items that cannot fit into a 45-liter bag should be disposed of as "bulk waste."



## Common mistakes (non-acceptable waste)

- Paper cups and paper containers (such as those for ice cream, instant noodles, yogurt, and other similar items) that are dirty or water-repellent.
  - ➔ Combustible waste

## Never put the following items in a waste bag.

- Hypodermic needles, syringes  
(The city does not accept dispose of them.)
- Scissors, razors (Non-combustible waste)
- Lighters, mobile batteries (Hazardous waste)



## Magazines, Books, Misc. papers (Resources)

Every two weeks

Put magazines and books in paper bags or tie them crosswise with string.



Fill shredded paper in a separate bag, air out, and tie the mouth of the bag.

### Acceptable waste

Magazines, books, sticky notes, memo paper, flyers, pamphlets, documents, canned beer paper packaging boxes, tissue boxes, paper packages, aluminum-coated paper cartons

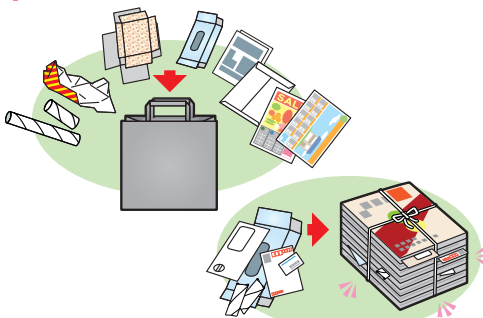
#### Precautions when disposing

- ① Remove the plastic opening from the tissue box and put it out on "Plastics" collection day.
- ② Cut off the transparent film of an envelope with a window and put it out on "combustible waste" collection day.



### Let's recycle scrap papers!

Small pieces that we usually throw away as combustible waste, such as memo paper, can also be recycled as magazines and books. Since miscellaneous papers come in different sizes, stuffing them in a paper bag may be easier than tying them up. If a paper bag is unavailable, they can be sandwiched between magazines, etc., and tied up as instructed for magazines and books.



### Common mistakes (non-acceptable waste)

Scented paper (detergent boxes), soiled paper (used tissues, etc.), waterproof paper (paper cups, yogurt containers, etc.), photos, receipts, iron-on transfer papers (stuffing bags and shoes, etc.), carbon-backed papers (receipts, etc.), vinyl-coated paper, cup noodle sealing lid, cushioned envelopes, sealed correspondence postcard **Dispose of all items above as "combustible waste".**

Even if the  mark is printed, you cannot recycle it.



## Cartons (Resources)

Every two weeks

Rinse inside carton, unfold and flatten. Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



- Remove the plastic spout from paper cardboard cartons and dispose of it as "plastics." (See page 5.)

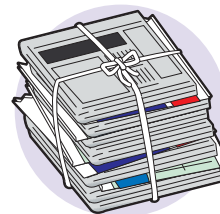
※ Paper cartons with an aluminum coating on the inside should be disposed of as miscellaneous paper.



## Newspapers / Flyers (Resources)

Every two weeks

Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



If you want to take it to the retailer, please attach the label provided by the retailer. If this label is displayed, the city will not collect it.

※ Advertising paper and flyers other than inserts will be disposed of as miscellaneous paper.



## Cardboard / Brown papers (Resources)

Every two weeks

Wrap with string, form a cross and tie a knot.



※ Peel off the packaging tape.

- Please dispose of used pizza boxes as "combustible" waste.
- Brown paper pieces can be disposed of in brown paper envelopes.

※ Brown paper has a brown torn cross-section.

**Paper resources cannot be recycled if they get wet in the rain.**

We will collect your items even on rainy days, but please try to put them out next time if possible. Even if you put it out on a rainy day, please put it in the same place as usual.

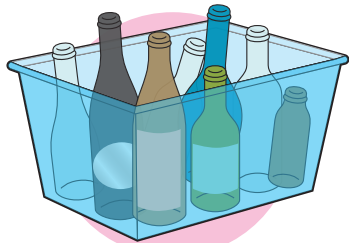


# Glass bottles (Resources)

(Beverages, foods, cosmetic bottles, etc.)

Once a week

Put in a basket or bucket.



- Put bottles in a designated crate, etc. provided by a multi-household complex.
- Do not put bottles into a plastic bag.

## Common mistakes (non-acceptable waste)

Plastic bottle caps → Plastics

Metal bottle caps → Non-combustible waste

Glass bottles for fruit wine, broken bottles → Non-combustible waste

Nail polish bottles, ceramic bottles, glass tableware → Non-combustible waste

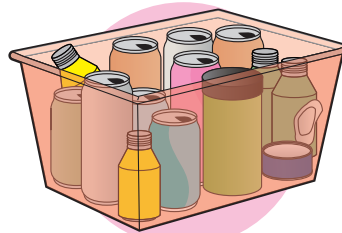


# Cans (Resources)

(Cans of beverages, food, sweets, etc.)

Every two weeks

Put in a basket or bucket.



- Put bottles in a designated crate, etc. provided by a multi-household complex.
- Do not put bottles into a plastic bag.

## Common mistakes (non-acceptable waste)

Spray Cans → Wednesday "Spray cans" (See page 8.)

Eighteen-liter drums → Bulk waste

Paint cans (designated as non-combustible waste if the remaining paint is wiped clean)

※The City does not dispose of cans in which paint is remaining.



# PET bottles (Resources)

(PET bottles for beverages, alcoholic beverages, and specific seasonings).

Once a week

Use transparent or translucent bags for waste up to 45 liters.

※You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.

## Bottle containers for drinking water, juice, and other foods

Please dispose of it to the collection box of the store where you bought it.



① Remove cap.



② Peel off label.



③ Rinse with water.



④ Squish sideways.

- Rinse lightly with water. Remove cap and label, discard as Plastics. (See page 5.)
- We do not collect anything other than bottles. Please dispose of them as plastic.



**PET bottles without this recycling symbol should be disposed of as Plastic Containers.**

[Examples] Cooking oils (salad dressings, salad oil), sauces and grilled meat sauces, non-food products (detergents, shampoos, cosmetics, medicines, etc.)

※Please dispose of PET bottles that are used for crafting or crushed vertically as non-combustible waste.



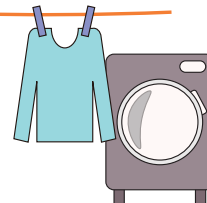
# Recyclable clothing (Resources)

(Clothing, fabrics)

Every two weeks

Use transparent or translucent bags for waste up to 45 liters.

※You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.



※Wash and dry used clothing before bagging them.



- Put items made of cotton other than clothing to Combustible waste (designated combustion waste bags).

**[Recyclable cloth cannot be used as a resource if it gets wet in the rain.]**

We will collect your items even on rainy days, but please put them out next time if possible. Even if you put it out on a rainy day, please put it in the same place as usual.

- ※Clothing will be reused. Please leave clothing with buttons and fasteners attached.
- ※Recyclable cloth can be disposed of even if it is torn.



# Pruned branches (Resources)

Once a week



- Please cut the pruned branches to approximately 50 cm (branch diameter up to 15 cm), and tie the length with string so that it can be held in one hand.
- Weekly disposal limit is up to 5 bundles.

## Unacceptable waste (wrong waste category)

Flowers, timber wood, bamboo, hemp palm, lacquer, oleanders, gatepost "Kadomatsu" are "Combustible waste" (Use yellow designated bags).  
 Note Leaves and weeds are also combustible waste. Use transparent or translucent bags for disposal. (See page 3.)

# Spray cans

Once a week

※You cannot use collection bags designated by other cities.



※DO NOT puncture holes.

※Cassette cylinders and aerosol cans (all cans and bottles containing gas such as deodorant sprays and hairdressing sprays)

Be sure to use up the gas.  
 These notations indicate cautions. 火気と高温に注意 火気に注意  
 Put only spray cans into transparent or translucent bags of less than 45 liters for disposal. (Do not mix spray cans with other hazardous waste.)

Users of carbon dioxide cylinders usually have to return them to the manufacturer. The city cannot collect them.

## FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

What should I do if there is still content in the spray bottle?  
 Please use a gas release cap or similar device to release the gas from the container in a well-ventilated outdoor area, away from open flames, before disposing of it.

Tires, tire wheels, batteries, auto parts, fire extinguishers, large safes, paints, dirt, rocks, sand (including fertilizer), pianos, agricultural chemicals, etc., gas canisters, (butane gas portable cartridges not included), toxic substances as medication, concrete, bricks, construction debris, oil, medical waste (hypodermic needles), kerosene, automobiles, etc.

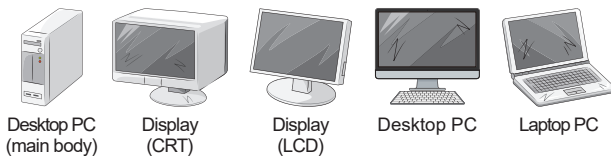
We do not accept interior restoration debris produced by contractors. Please arrange disposal directly with contractors.

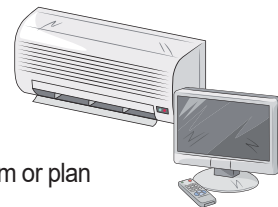

## Items subject to Home Appliance Recycling Act

Discard these items using one of the following methods: air conditioners, TV sets, refrigerators, warm/cold storage, freezers, washing machines, and clothes dryers.



### ① When requesting the store where you are replacing the product or the store where you purchased the product

Pay the recycling and shipping fee to the retailer who you purchased from or plan to exchange.

### ② When requesting collection from a city-designated company

You can purchase a home appliance recycling ticket at a post office or check the city's website to find a collection and transportation service provider.

### ③ When you bring it by yourself

Purchase a home appliance recycling ticket at a post office and bring it to the designated collection site.

### How to reserve bulk waste collections

**1 Measure item size (height x width x depth, especially mid to large items, such as kitchen cabinets and drawer chests).**



**2 Apply for bulk waste collection.**

After applying, we will inform you about the collection date, points, etc. Since there are many applications on weekdays after holidays (especially in the morning), it is difficult to connect to the phone. Please call after a while.



**3 Purchase Bulk Waste Ticket.** (See page 23 for retailers.)

If you apply from the Internet, you can pay online (by credit card or PayPay). (Scheduled to start in late January 2025)



**4 Discharge by 8 am on the day of collection.**

If you have paid online, please attach the form with the necessary information specified by the city. We will collect the waste by the evening of the collection day. In principle, there is no need for you to be present.



※For detailed instructions on how to dispose of waste, please see the two-dimensional code here.



- NOTES**
- Bulk waste collection is limited to once a month.
  - Recollection is not available within one month from the collection day in the same household.
  - Up to 20 points can be earned per collection.
  - For moving out purposes, please plan waste collections systematically.
  - The mounting sheet that remains after pasting the processing ticket on the item will serve as your receipt. Please keep it in a safe place until the collection is complete.

### Waste Fee Reduction/Exemption System

Those who meet the following requirements qualify for the bulk waste fee exemption. For more details, contact the Waste Management Division.

- Livelihood protection beneficiaries
- Persons who are provided a disability certificate, etc.

All households are exempt from municipal tax and meet the following requirements.

- Issued Class 1 or 2 of the Physically Disabled Handbook
  - Issued Class 1 of Mental Illness Health and Welfare Handbook
  - Issued Class 1 or 2 of the Aino-Techo Handbook
- Those who were affected by disasters such as fire and flood damage
